- Wednesday morning walks are generally 6-7 miles, finishing by 1.00pm.
- Weekdav long walks are generally 9-12 miles, finishing mid afternoon.
- Weekday ambles are short walks (5 miles or less) conducted at a leisurely
- pace and may be of particular interest to those new or returning to walking.
