## Ivel Valley Walkers

Walks on:-

**Sundays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, Fridays,**

**Sunday walks** are either two half days usually with a morning walk of 7 miles and an afternoon walk of about 5 miles, or one full day of 12+ miles, ending about 4:00pm.

**Tuesday walks** are generally 9-12 miles, conducted at a brisk pace with shorter stops, finishing mid afternoon. Please bring food and drinks for the whole day.

**Wednesday morning walks** are generally 6-7 miles, finishing by 1:00pm.

**Thursday ambles and informative walks** are short walks of 5 miles or less conducted at a leisurely pace and may be of particular interest to those new or returning to walking.

**Friday bus walks** have a bus component, either the chance to reach the start point with the bus or integrated within the walk.

**Summer evening walks** are of 4 - 4.5 miles, on various weekdays and start at either 7:00pm or 7:30pm.

### Notes for walkers:

- Please make sure that you are fit enough to undertake the walk; if you are unsure of your fitness level, try a short and easy walk first.
- **Please park considerably on the road if there is no dedicated car park.**
- Most Ramblers' walks are off-road in rural areas. Please have suitable footwear and clothing; leaders may not accept participants who in their opinion are inadequately equipped or unfit.
- For your own and others' safety please read and abide by any advice and guidelines issued by the organizer, and the instructions of the walk leader. Though walking is inherently one of the safest outdoor activities, no activity is completely without risk and it is your responsibility to behave sensibly and to minimize the potential for accidents to occur.
- If you wish to bring a dog on any walk, please contact the leader before you walk to check suitability.
- Most walks have a refreshment break; please bring packed lunch if out all day.
- Please be aware that our walks always depart at the time stated.
- The walks are free, but if you walk regularly with us we would like you to join the Ramblers Association.

This Greensand Trust organized event will consist of 3 separate linear walks within the Greensand Country Festival through the beautiful mix of woodland, meadows, fields and heaths between Leighton Buzzard and Gamlingay. Each day, participants will park at the end location for that day and board a coach for transfer to the walk start – see below.

**Day 1 – 3<sup>rd</sup> May** - meet in Ridgmont village for coach transfer to Leighton Buzzard - walk back to Ridgmont.

**Day 2 – 17<sup>th</sup> May** – meet in Haynes for coach transfer to Ridgmont - walk back to Haynes.
