Later in the year there will hopefully be a Long Weekend Break in the Malvern countryside and another Sunday coach trip.

After the very successful 10 day Greensand Country Festival in May 2018, planning is now underway for the 2019 Festival which might be extended to cover the full month of May 2019.

Could you please make sure that this permission is in place by registering on the main Ramblers website.

Last, but not least, an apology to all leaders and walkers for our having not been explicit regarding the change to afternoon start times for Sunday split walks; i.e. on occasions when we return to the start location at lunchtime. Some months ago the committee decided that the start time for those arriving for the afternoon should be 13:30pm. However, the committee also recommended a 45 minute lunch break which the leader might reduce to a minimum of 30 minutes in exceptional circumstances. The length of the break will be decided on the day by the walk leader depending on the time the morning walk ends but the afternoon walk will never start before the published time of 13:30pm.

# **Ivel Valley Walkers**

#### Walks on:-

#### Sundays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, Fridays, Summer evenings and some Saturdays

**Sunday walks** are either two half days usually with a morning walk of 7 miles and an afternoon walk of about 5 miles, or one full day of 12+ miles, ending about 4:00pm.

**Tuesday walks** are generally 9-12 miles, finishing mid afternoon.

Wednesday morning walks are generally 6-7 miles, finishing by 1:00pm.

**Thursday ambles and informative walks** are short walks of 5 miles or less conducted at a leisurely pace and may be of particular interest to those new or returning to walking.

**Friday bus walks** have a bus component, either the chance to reach the start point with the bus or integrated within the walk.

**Summer evening walks** are of 4 - 4.5 miles, on various weekdays and start at either 7:00pm or 7:30pm.

#### Notes for walkers:

- Please make sure that you are fit enough to undertake the walk; if you are unsure of your fitness level, try a short and easy walk first.

- Most Ramblers' walks are off-road in rural areas. Please have suitable footwear and clothing; leaders may not accept participants who in their opinion are inadequately equipped or unfit.

- For your own and others' safety please read and abide by any advice and guidelines issued by the organisers, and the instructions of the walk leader. Though walking is inherently one of the safest outdoor activities, no activity is completely without risk and it is your responsibility to behave sensibly and to minimise the potential for accidents to occur.

- If you wish to bring a dog on any walk, please contact the leader before to check suitability.

- Most walks have a refreshment break; please bring packed lunch if out all day.
- Please be aware that our walks always depart at the time stated.

- The walks are free, but if you walk regularly with us we would like you to join the Ramblers.
